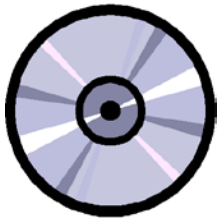

Reduce - Reuse - Recycle Hierarchy

REUSE higher on the pyramid than RECYCLING.

More savings with REUSE.



- Reduce** - Packaging is 32% of our waste. Buy in bulk with reusable container. Buy long-lasting repairable products.
- Reuse** - Donate to extend product life (chart below). Avoid single use products. Use reusable water bottles. Buy used.
- Recycle** - Use single stream blue cart. Recycle more and downsize your trash cart to reduce your utility bill.
- * 25% of our trash is food waste. Compost to recycle. See www.austintexas.gov/departments/composting.
- * Take unusual materials to specialized locations for best use and highest savings (see recycling chart).
- * Recycling 15 pounds of mixed recyclables/wk saves same greenhouse gas emissions as driving 40 miles/wk. k
