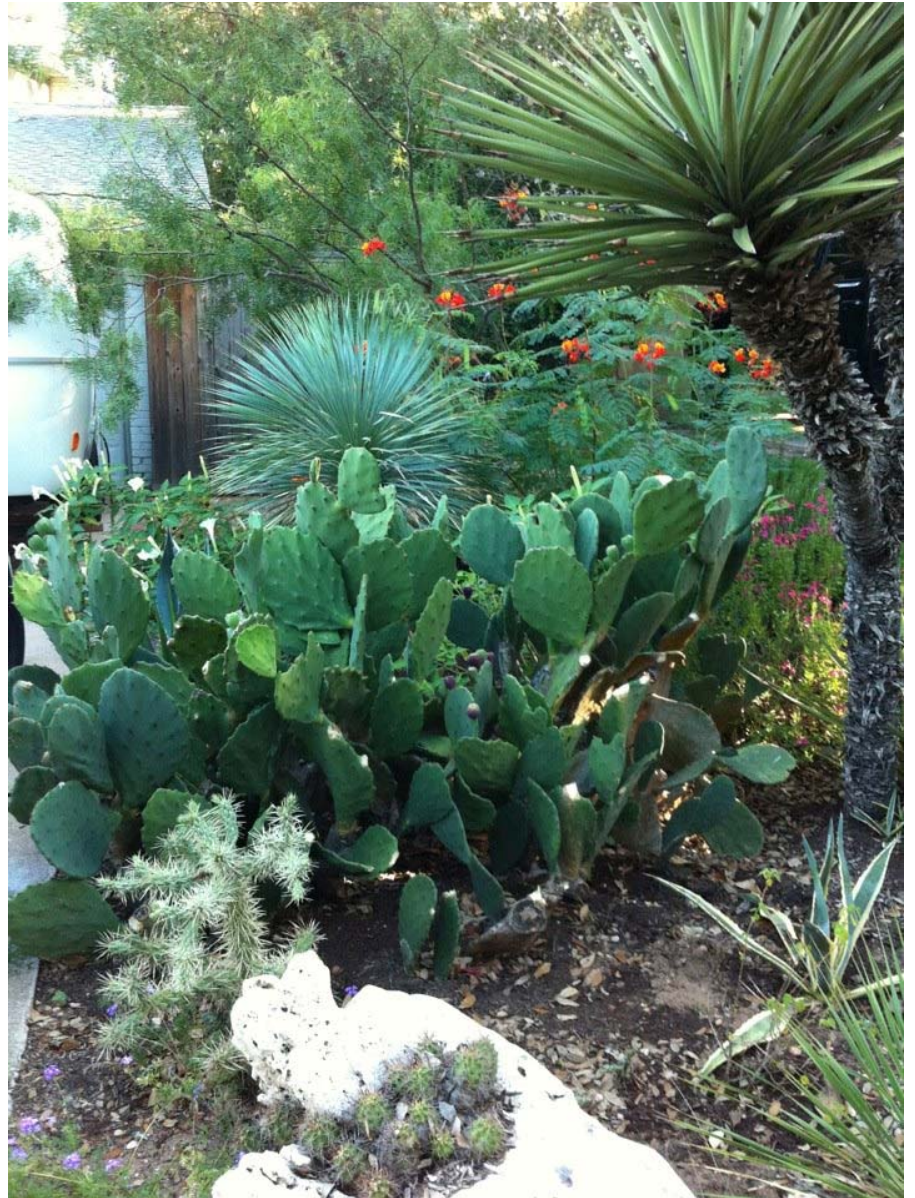

- **Plant list: Yellow and Red Pride of Barbados, Salvia (red, white, pink), Lantana, Santolina, Mexican Sage, Knockout Roses, Soft Yucca, Vinca, Rosemary, Datura, Rose Grass, and more**

- **Plant list: 10 kinds of cactus, 2 bamboo species, Blood Lily, Crinum Lily, Sedum, trumpet vine, fig vine, several Agave varieties, several Sotol, several Nolina, Dyckia, Manfreda “chocolate chips,” Standing Cypress, Texas Blue grass, Foxtail Fern, Clematis, ...**

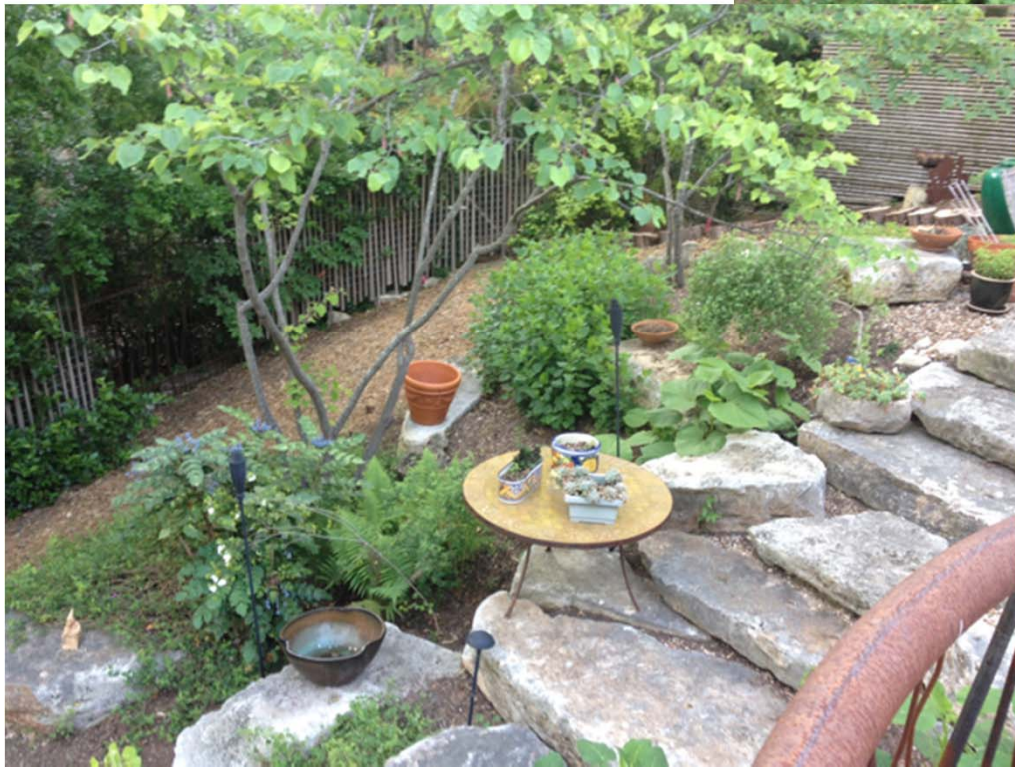
