

024 July 4th Parade Participant Information

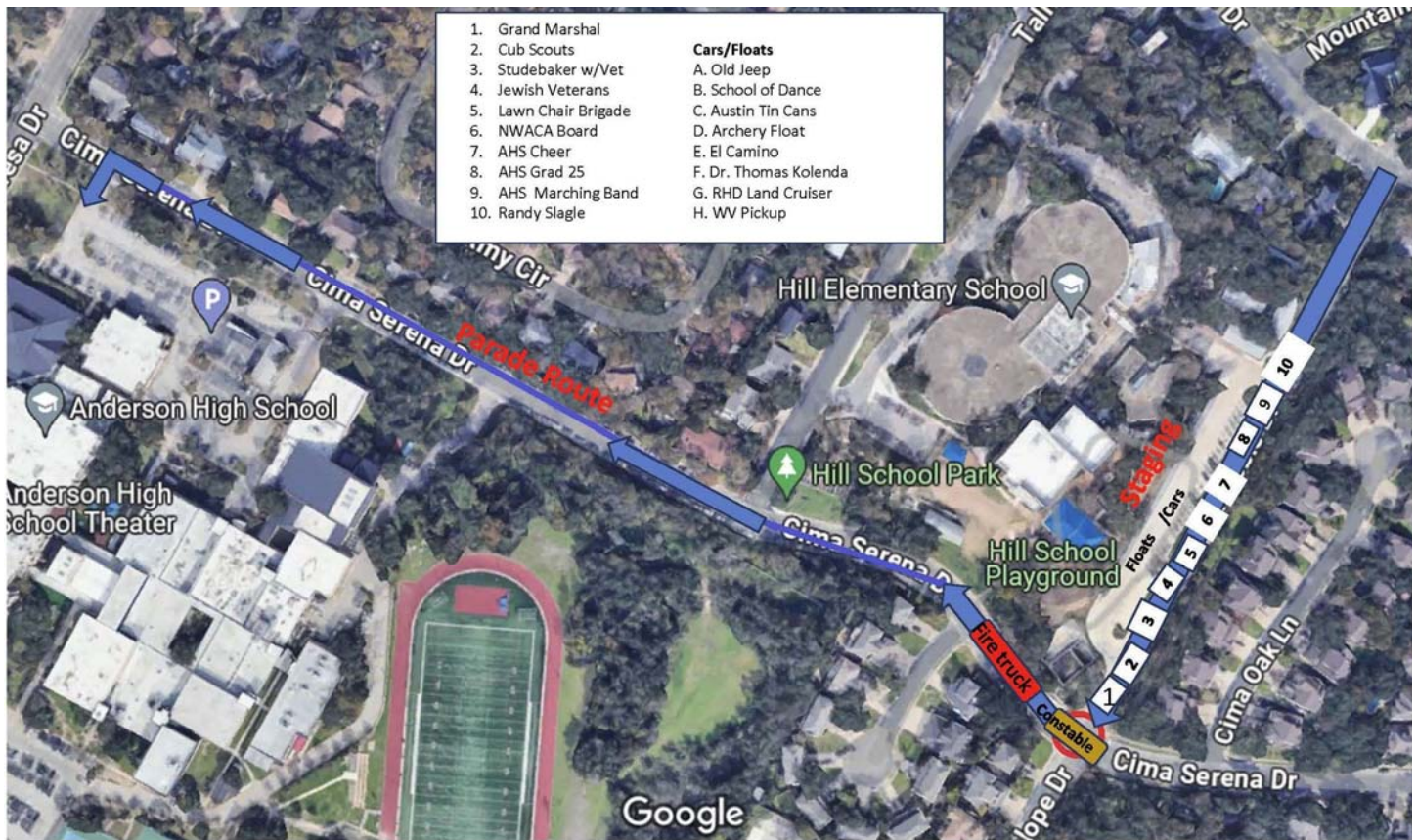
Parade Route: Cima Serena Drive from Robbie Drive to the North Parking Lot of Anderson High School; vehicles joining the parade should enter Robbie Drive from Hyridge Drive, turning south onto Robbie Drive, parking in the Hill Elementary School Parking Lot, along with floats facing south.

When to arrive:

- 8:00 – 8:15 – Floats – come into Hill Elementary Parking Lot, facing south
- 8:00 – 8:15 – Fire truck, constable, Grand Marshal line up at front of parade
- 8:15 – 8:30 – Car with veteran, Scouts, lawn chair brigade, AHS groups, band members line up
- 8:30 – 8:45 – Walkers, kids on bikes, line up after the band
- 8:30 – 8:45 – Specialty cars enter Hill Elementary Parking Lot, as directed

Opening ceremonies: Intersection of Cima Serena and Robbie **9:00** – Judy Maggio, MC and Grand Marshal

Parade kicks off about 9:15; Freedom Fest follows in Anderson High North Parking Lot. As parade finishes, specialty cars proceed into North Parking lot, as directed by greeters. Floats proceed to Mesa, turn south and go into South Parking lot, returning banners to the NWACA booth.



Where to Park: People watching the parade or walking in the parade can park their cars in the South Parking Lot at Anderson High or in the Westover Church parking lot across the street.

Freedom Fest: The fun-filled freedom fest will include music by the Anderson High band, a bounce house, a petting zoo, many games for kids and lots of food – watermelon, tacos, donuts, burgers/hot dogs, Kona Ice snow cones, iced coffee and tea, water, and more!
