

Parade Route: Far West Blvd to Doss Parking Lot

#### Parade Line-Up:

-Motorized vehicles participating in float contest line up by 8:00 AM. (Register at NWACA.org)

-All other motorized vehicles line up by 8:30 AM

-**Pedestrians** organized groups (Scouts, gymnastic groups, robotics, etc) walking in the parade line up by 8:30 AM followed by individuals on scooters, bikes, pulling wagons, etc.


Waterline Rd. Once the parade starts, you will file onto Farter-Je West Blvd to march in the parade. Pedestrians encouraged to access parade line via Greystone Dr., Deepwoods Dr. or Cat Hollow Dr. to Waterline Rd.

Motorized vehicles participating in the parade line up on the south-west side of the street (Far West Blvd.), west of Waterline Rd. Vehicles encouraged to access parade line via Greystone, Valburn, Ladera Norte to Far West Blvd.; 2222 (or 360), Lakewood Dr., Driftwood Dr., etc to Ladera Norte to Far West Blvd. (North Hills Dr. at Far West Blvd will be closed to through traffic).

### Parade end:

-Floats proceed to the parking lot on the north side of Doss Elementary (on the right, across from Chimney Corners)

-Antique cars and other vehicles proceed past Doss Elementary down Far West Blvd; those who want to show their cars at the Freedom Festival, proceed to Hart Lane and turn right, and turn right again on North Hills Drive and park in the southern parking lot at Doss Elementary

-Walkers, bicycles, and other marching groups proceed to the Freedom Festival at Doss Elementary
